

**THE REGISTRAR OF THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE AGENT’S COUNCIL
 (“APAC”)**

V

FAIZEL ISMAIL GAFFOOR

On 28 November 2013 and at Brooklyn, Pretoria, the Accused was found guilty of unprofessional and improper conduct and acting in contravention of the provisions of the Agricultural Produce Agent's Act, No. 12 of 1992 ("the Act") in that :

1. there were shortages in the agricultural produce stock of the Accused’s principal, which shortfall was not properly accounted for, and which agricultural stock formed part of the principal’s trust account,
2. the Accused failed to keep full and correct accounting records of all monies received, kept and/or expended and of all agricultural produce received, kept and sold and more particularly, failed to sell agricultural stock in accordance with allocated consignment numbers.

SANCTION

1. The Accused was ordered to pay a fine of R15 000.00 of which, the sum of R5 000.00 was suspended for a period of 3 years on the condition that the Accused is not found guilty of a similar offence.
2. The Accused was directed to make a contribution towards the costs of APAC in the amount of R15 000.00.
